There are a number of ways you can include Perth Children's Hospital Foundation in your Will.

A Residual Gift

Leave the 'residue' or leftover of your estate (or a percentage of this residue) to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation after all other gifts, expenses, and debts have been paid.

A Pecuniary Gift

Leave a specific sum of money to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation.

A Percentage Gift

Leave a percentage of your estate, or a percentage of the residue, to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation.

An Asset Gift

Share your assets with Perth Children's Hospital Foundation from real estate to shares and bonds or other items of value.
