- Some have worked in the hospital and appreciate how a gift in Will can help children and adolescents, now and into the future

### Olivia's story.

Olivia, using a FrameRunner funded by PCHF.

Thanks to a FrameRunner funded by Perth Children's Hospital Foundation, Olivia is pursuing an Olympic dream.

She sustained an Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) following the removal of a brain tumour when she was just eight years old. Prior to her tumour, Olivia was very active, taking part in dance and sports, but her ABI has affected her balance and movement.

In 2021, Olivia was introduced to the sport of FrameRunning, an inclusive recreation and rehabilitation activity for people with conditions affecting mobility or balance. Essentially a three-wheeled 'running bike' with a saddle, FrameRunners allow users to easily propel themselves forward using one or both feet.

With the support of Perth Children's Hospital Foundation, Olivia has her own FrameRunner to practice with as she sets her sights on competing in the Paralympics.

**"It was very difficult for Olivia following the removal of the tumour because she struggled with not being as active as she once was. It was amazing watching Olivia in the FrameRunner for the first time. She has a very competitive streak and it's difficult to find an all-ability activity like FrameRunning, so it's been really fantastic.**

## A Residual Gift

Leave the 'residue' or leftover of your estate (or a percentage of this residue) to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation after all other gifts, expenses and debts have been paid.

## A Percentage Gift

Leave a percentage of your estate, or a percentage of the residue, to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation.

## A Pecuniary Gift

Leave a special sum of money to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation.

## An Asset Gift

Share your assets with Perth Children's Hospital Foundation, from real estate to shares and bonds or other items of value.

## Generous gift to live on.

Through hard work as a toolmaker and a modest lifestyle, Wembley man John Street accumulated a multi-million dollar fortune. His wish was for it to be left to something substantial that would benefit society for years to come.

Known as a kind and humble man, Mr Street wanted to leave the money in memory of his sister who died of throat cancer.

Following his death in 2010, Mr Street's estate was bequeathed to the Cancer Council WA which gifted \$6m to the Perth Children's Hospital Foundation for WA's first children's hospice.

Mr Street's generous gift demonstrates the impact of leaving a legacy.
